

## Steps to import mp3 backing track into JamMan Solo XT


- 1. Download the mp3 backing track
- 2. Use DAW such as Audacity to convert .mp3 to .wav file
- 3. Plug JamMan Solo XT into computer USB
- 4. Start Digitech JamManager XT v2.35 (Windows)
- 5. Synchronize the Library if there are new loops you want to save
- 6. Click Library
- 7. Click Add to Library icon
- 8. Select the .wav file you want to import. In this example I just imported ep280-minus-guitar



9. Click the imported track and click the options icon. Change the native tempo to the tempo of the backing track.



- 10. Click the split view icon and select either a JamList or the JamMan in the upper list.
- 11. Drag the backtrack you want from the lower list to the upper list



12. Exit JamManager and unplug the JamMan usb
